All abstract submissions must (1) contain the title of the paper, author's name(s), affiliation(s), author's full postal address(es) and e-mail; (2) contain no more than 200 words; and (3) indicate the category to which the abstract is most relevant (multiple categories acceptable). The categories are:

Architecture Information Science Computer Science Mathematics

Material Science Education Science Engineering Technology

Please indicate any special media requirements at the time of abstract submission. Abstracts and full papers should be prepared as PC compatible MS Word files in Font-Times New Roman, Size 12. Presentations should be PowerPoint files. No PDF Files. Poster sizes should be 3'X5'. All files should be delivered on 'virus-free' USB drives. The presentation time is 12 minutes.
